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**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE YAKAMA NATION
TREATY DAY Drive Thru Parade Wednesday, June 9th, 2021**

1. **Deadline for parade applications will be Friday, June 4th, 2021** before 5pm. Please state if there will be more than one vehicle or entry on your parade application.
2. On-site registration and set-up will open at 7:30 am the day of parade.
3. You must check in at the registration table prior to line-up to receive your number and spot for the parade.
4. Registration will close promptly at 8:30 a.m. to ensure the parade begins on time. Please place your parade number in the front of your parade entry in plain view.
5. Only Vehicles/Floats entering the parade will have entrance to parade line up parking. **NO PERSONAL VEHICLES ALLOWED TO PARK IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE PARADE LINE UP.** You will be allowed to drop off decorations only no parking. Parking will be allowed at the Yakama Nation RV Park.
6. Float participants must wear a mask and maintain social distancing following COVID-19 Guidelines. Must supply own sanitizer for float area.
7. There will be a 10-person limit per parade float between 9am-1pm and there will be no intermingling between floats to maintain social distancing. Helpers above the 10-person limit assisting with fabrication, set-up, decorating, and/or clean up must clear the area before 8:45am and return after 1:00pm.
8. Judging will take place by ballots from the community in attendance at the drive thru parade
9. Float space is limited to 30ft spaces; due to limited space, no semis allowed.
10. If you plan on giving out candy or passing out information, it must be pre-bagged and ready for handout. There must be runners ready for handouts. **DO NOT HOLD TRAFFIC UP.**
11. Floats with horses must provide their own cleanup crew (pooper scoopers)
12. We appreciate all YN Elected Officials and YN Employees participation and encourage your program to decorate your float according to the parade theme.
